

# Nurse Practitioner FAQ's

## Nurse Practitioners cannot bill Medicare, so why should I 'shadow' bill?

Nurse Practitioners are encouraged to shadow bill regardless of their employer, because the more data captured by the government of New Brunswick, the better it is for future research and/or for future health-care planning, including nurse practitioner data.

The regional health authorities require shadow billing as part of their employment, but NPs employed outside the health authority, should also shadow bill.
